

Notice to parents with children under the age of 13:

Easy Hard Science (learnwithdrscott.com) is committed to protecting the privacy of children who use our site and services. There is a U.S. federal law called COPPA (*Children's Online Privacy Protection Act*) that needs to be followed. This rule was created in 1999 and revised in 2013.

IMPORTANT: Federal regulations require your signature on page 2.

Below is the information you need to actually protect your child's privacy, in addition to complying with an outdated law.

1. Our web site tracks minimal user data. It does, however, require logging in. Create your log in using a **parent email** (any receipts are sent here also). **When creating your login: never use a child's email, never provide a child's full name, and never give a street address.** We don't want that info, and parents shouldn't be providing it online in the first place. Be safe.
2. Parents should email homework submissions, etc. **Don't allow your child to email us.** Stay in the loop. Be responsible.
3. The main way your child can be tracked on the internet is by IP address (your address on the internet). This is just how the internet works. By opting in on page 2, you recognize that an IP address may be tracked by analytics services such as Google Analytics or Facebook Pixel.
4. We use third party services such as Zoom (for live classes) and Vimeo (for pre-recorded lesson videos). They don't require logging in. **Do not allow your child to create logins with Zoom or Vimeo.** Zoom does not even allow persons under 18 years of age to create accounts in the first place.
