

Safety Policy for Families This is a 1-page guide for homeschool families to keep home

science safe, legal, and aligned with the scientific method.

All learners in any class must follow the following Safety Policy rules.

- 1. Safety First. Always.*
- 2. During live lessons:
 - a. Video feeds must be on, generally, unless there's a doctor's note.
 - b. We take short movement breaks, because prolonged sitting is unhealthy. Video feeds may be off.
- 3. No unsafe experiments or science projects. Ever.
 - a. For chemistry courses, all learners must complete the Science Safety Rules Agreement.**
 - b. For chemistry courses, all learners must complete the safety analysis of the experiment(s) to get credit for the course.
 - c. For chemistry courses, you may use simulated data as a safe option instead of setting up experiments at home.
 - d. If you do opt to set up any experiment at home, you must follow the Science Safety Rules** and authorized procedures or instructions.
 - e. Before doing extracurricular science activities, it's advised to have a parent inform Dr. Scott by email (dr.scott.beaver@gmail.com). You need approval if the Safety Policy has been broken previously.
